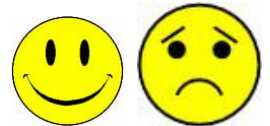
PROCEED to MONROE ELEMENTARY (e-MINTS) SCHOOL, 3641 MISSOURI AT S. BROADWAY (RE-OPENED 2001);



THEN walk to CARNAHAN HIGH SCHOOL OF THE FUTURE, 4041 S. BROADWAY (recommended by Superintendent to remain open for now, if enough enrollment & support);



TURN corner to MERAMEC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, 2745 MERAMEC (recommended by Superintendent to remain open for now, if enough enrollment & support);



CONCLUDE AT CLEVELAND HIGH SCHOOL, 3452 LOUISIANA (closed), where Alliance to Save Cleveland High School will present an option for a new model of public education in St. Louis.



Note: If you do not believe you will be able to make the entire walk and return home or back to Shepard School, you might consider driving from location to location. The easiest route is to go southeast on Wisconsin from Shepard Elementary to S. Broadway; go south on South Broadway to Monroe; go south on Broadway to Carnahan; go south to Meramec (one block) and west to Meramec School (one block); go west on Meramec to Virginia; go south on Virginia to Osceola (rear of Cleveland High); go west on Osceola to Louisiana.
